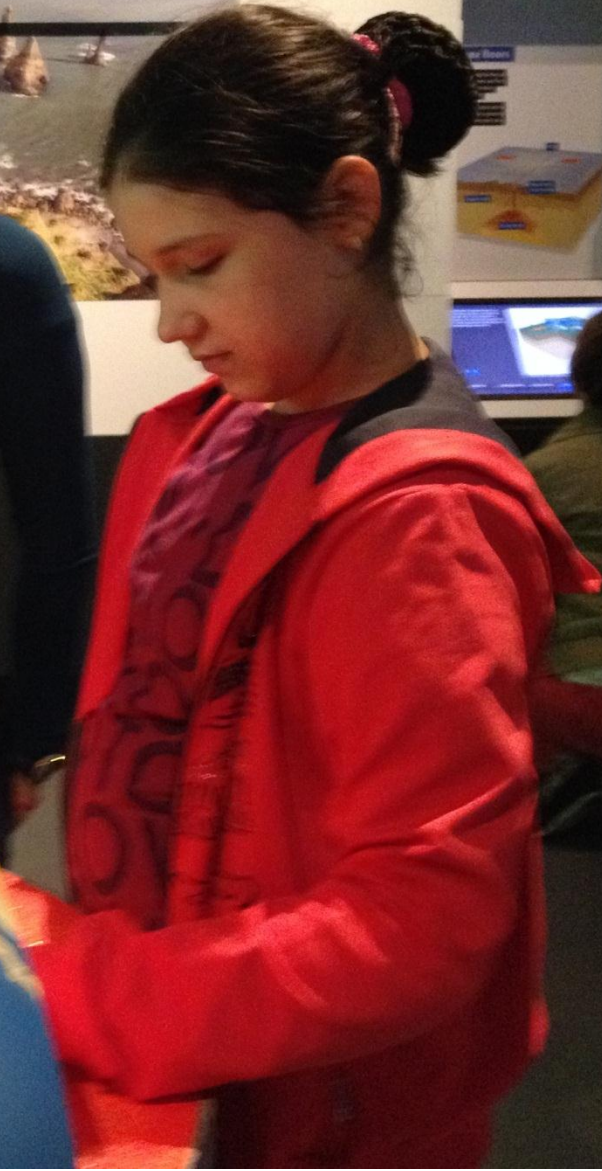
MOUNTAINS UNDER THE SEA
